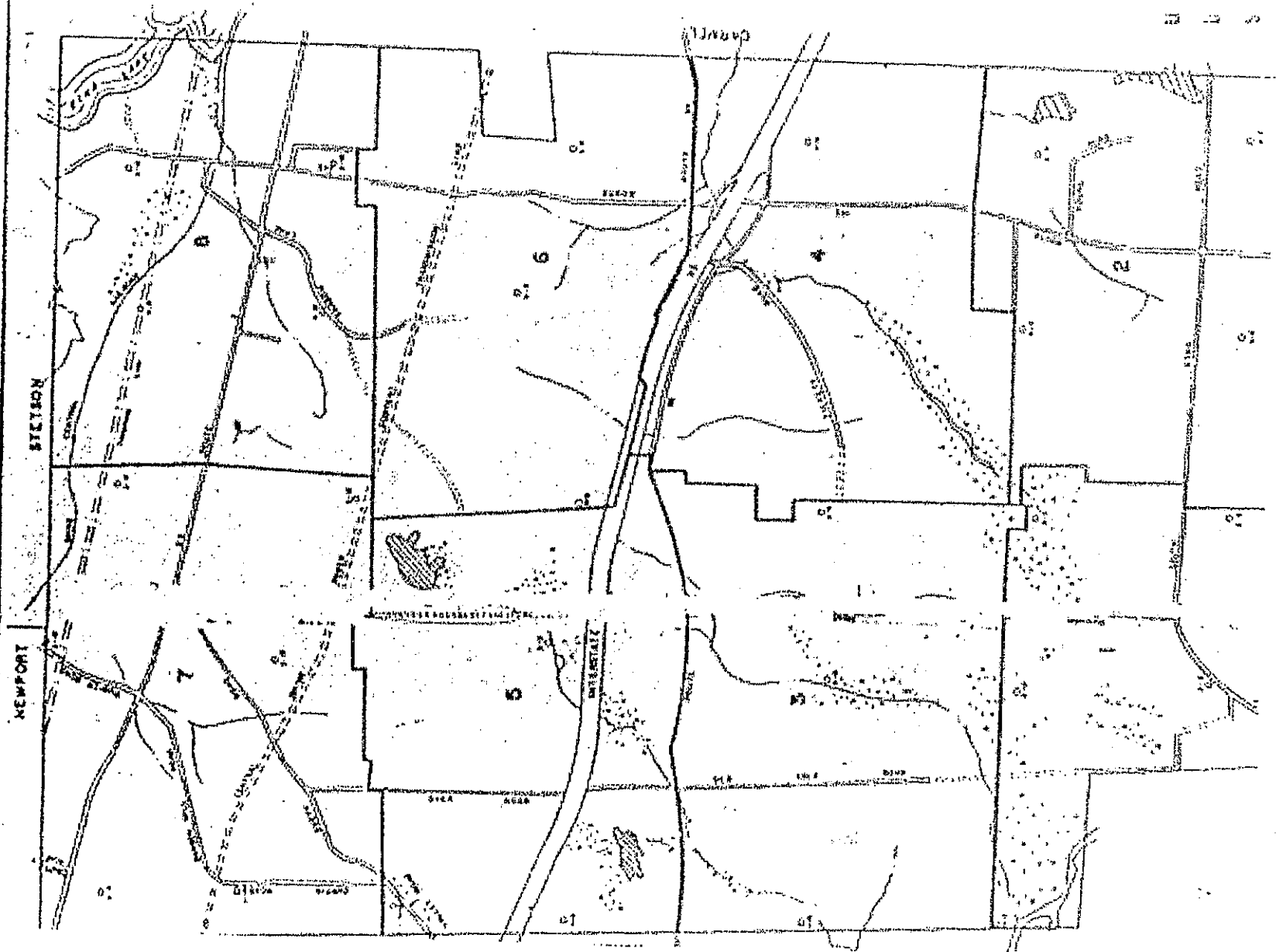

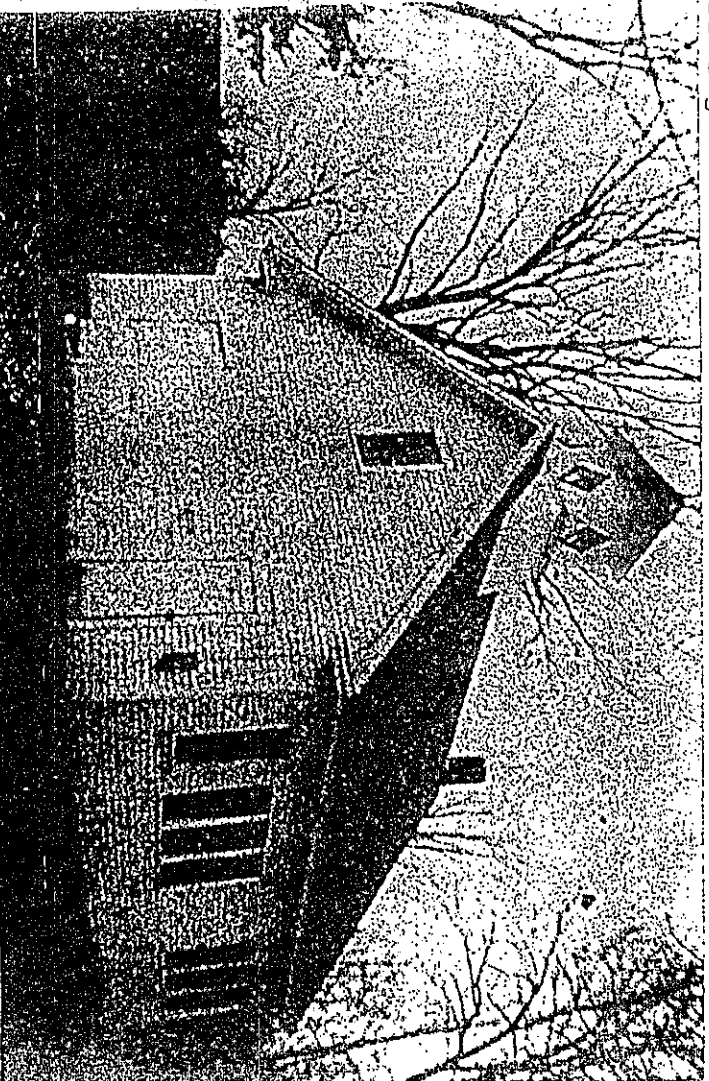

## SCHOOLS OF THE PAST

At one time there were up to eight schools. (this provided one within walking distance of each family.) By the 1920, there were just four schools; McKinley School at North Etna, Lincoln School at Etna Center, Washington School at West Etna, and Longfellow School at South Etna. These schools were used until 1968, when the present school was built.

The Lincoln School is owned by Crawford Carter and still looks about the same as it did on the outside, but the inside has been made into an apartment. The McKinley School has been made into a complete house owned by Gloria (Conant) Wilson Cavanaugh. The Washington School has been destroyed and the Longfellow School is owned by Gerald Gould. (It looks about the same except the belfry and roof have been replaced.) There were eight grades in each school until in the late fifties or early sixties; there were four and five grades to a school.



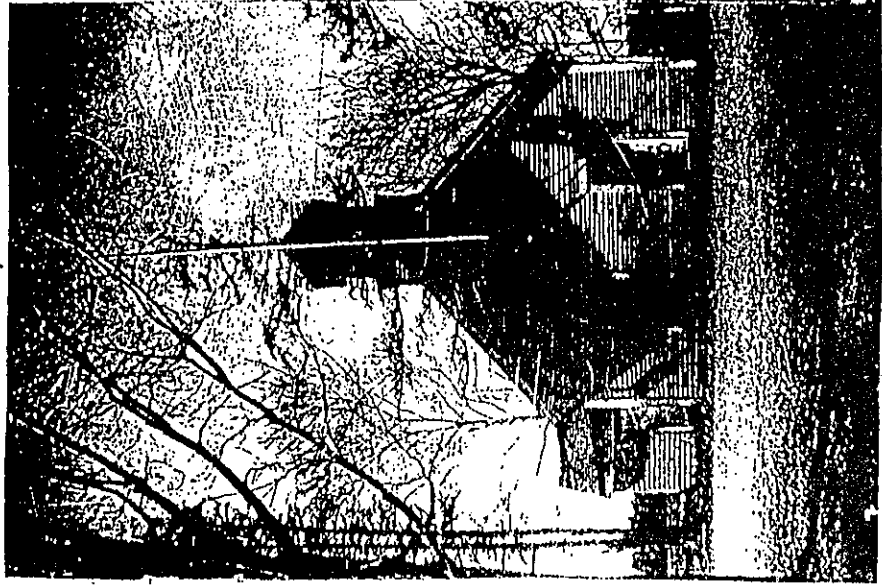
